No 892-N of 15 July 2010

ON APPROVING THE SCHEDULE

**OF MEASURES PROVIDED FOR BY THE NATIONAL PROGRAMME ON COMBATING DRUG
ADDICTION AND ILLICIT TRAFFIC IN NARCOTIC DRUGS IN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
IN 2010-2012**

In accordance with point 2 of the Executive Order of the President of the Republic of Armenia
NK-162-N of 25 September 2009, the Government of the Republic of Armenia ***decides:***

1. To approve the schedule of measures provided for by the National Programme on Combating Drug Addiction and Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs in the Republic of Armenia in 2010-2012, pursuant to the Annex.
2. This Decision shall enter into force on the tenth day following the day of the official promulgation.
