**GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**DECISION**

No 821 of 25 December 1998 Yerevan

**ON APPROVING THE PASSPORT SYSTEM CHARTER IN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA  
AND THE DESCRIPTION OF THE PASSPORT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA  
CITIZENS**

Due to the need of improving the passport system charter in the Republic of Armenia and bringing it in line with the international standards, the Government of the Republic of Armenia hereby ***decides:***

1. To approve:

- (a) the passport system charter in the Republic of Armenia (attached);
- (b) the description of the passport of the Republic of Armenia Citizens (attached);
- (c) (subpoint repealed by No. 974-N of 23 June 2011)

2. To assign the performance of and control over the organising operations of the passport system in the Republic of Armenia to the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia, whereas in foreign states, to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Armenia.

3. The instruction on the procedure for the application of the passport system charter in the Republic of Armenia shall be approved by the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia.

4. To assign the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia to submit the form and the description of an insert in Russian enclosed to the passport of the Republic of Armenia citizens to the Government of the Republic of Armenia for approval, within a three-month period.

5. In points 1 and 2 of Decision No. 8 of the Government of the Republic of Armenia of 13 January 1997 "On extending the validity period of internal, foreign and official passports of the citizens of the former USSR" (edited by Decision No. 596 of the Government of the Republic of Armenia of 23 December 1997), the words "31 December 1998" shall be replaced with the words "1 July 1999".

6. Decision No. 473 of the Government of the Republic of Armenia of 11 September 1992 on approving the passport system charter in the Republic of Armenia and the description of the passport of the Republic of Armenia citizens" shall be repealed, except for point 4 of the Decision.

7. This Decision shall enter into force from 25 December 1998.

**CHARTER**  
**of the Passport System in the Republic of Armenia**

**I. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

1. The passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia is the main identification document of the citizen in the Republic of Armenia and in foreign states.

The holder of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia shall be under the patronage of the Republic of Armenia.

All citizens having attained the age of 16 shall be obliged to have the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia, irrespective of the place of residence.

Citizens of the Republic of Armenia not having attained the age of 16 shall be issued the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia upon their request and on the basis of an application submitted by one parent or a legal representative. ***(sentence deleted by No. 974-N of 23 June 2011)***

Citizens of the Republic of Armenia under the age of 16 shall be issued the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia without adding observations about registration to the passport.

In case if the citizens of the Republic of Armenia are documented with the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia before they attain the age of 16, the passport shall be

issued for a 3-year validity period, whereas for male minors having attained the age of 15, until attaining the age of 18.

The passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia under the age of 16, having been issued to a citizen of the Republic of Armenia not having attained the age of 16 may be exchanged on the basis of an application of one parent or a legal representative prior to expiration of the validity period of the passport.

Observations about the parents (first name, last name) shall be added to the "Observations" section on the fifth page of the passports of minors under the age of 16. In case of deceased parents or parents declared missing in the manner prescribed by law no observations shall be added to the "Observations" section on the fifth page of the passport.

The Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia shall, once every quarter, transfer to the Republican Military Commissariat of the Ministry of Defence of the Republic of Armenia the data (first name, last name, patronymic name, place of residence (registration) of the parents) about males having attained the age of 15 and documented with the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia.

2. The passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia shall be produced with a uniform sample, in Armenian and English and an insert in Russian shall be issued upon the request of the citizen.

For issuing an insert in Russian duty shall be levied on the citizen in the manner and amount prescribed by the Law of the Republic of Armenia "On State Duty".

3. The passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia having attained the age of 16 shall be issued for a period of 10 years. In the Republic of Armenia the validity period of usable passports shall be extended for a five-year period by the Police of the Republic of Armenia

adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia, whereas in foreign states, by the diplomatic representations or consular offices of the Republic of Armenia.

Expired passports are invalid and shall be exchanged in the prescribed manner.

4. In foreign states the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia shall be valid for up to 5 years.

5. The following information about the citizen shall be recorded in the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia:

(a) last name, first name, also patronymic name — on the page in Armenian;

(b) place, day, month, year of birth;

(c) gender;

(d) citizenship;

(e) personal number;

5.1. For foreign citizens of Armenian origin having acquired citizenship of the Republic of Armenia or having received the special residence status in the Republic of Armenia:

(a) the English record of the last name and the first name in the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia or in the special passport of the Republic of Armenia shall coincide with the English record made in the passport of the given person issued in the foreign state;

(b) the transcription of the last name and the first name from English to Armenian shall be done in literary Armenian. In case of petition of a foreign citizen of Armenian origin having acquired citizenship of the Republic of Armenia the transcription of his or her last name and the first name from English to Armenian shall be done in his or her preferred version;

(c) in cases of transcription of the first name and the last name not covered by the rules referred to in subpoints (a) and (b) and in cases presenting special difficulties the reference issued by the State Language Inspectorate of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Armenia shall be accepted as a basis.

5.2. The English record of the last name and the first name of the citizens of the Republic of Armenia, except for citizens referred to in point 5.1 of this Charter shall be made in accordance with the rules of transcription approved by the state administration body authorised by the Government of the Republic of Armenia in the education sector.

5.3. The English record of the first name, the last name and the patronymic name of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia born in a foreign state must coincide with the English record made in the document (birth certificate) issued to him/her by the foreign state.

5.4. In case of getting married to a citizen of a foreign state and taking his or her last name, the English record of the last name taken after marriage in the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia must coincide with the English record in the passport of his or her spouse and in the document attesting to the fact of marriage.

6. The following observations may be added to the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia:

(a) on the extension of the validity period of the passport by the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia in the Republic of Armenia, whereas in foreign states, by the diplomatic representations or consular offices of the Republic of Armenia;

(b) on the validity periods of the passport in foreign states by the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia in the Republic of Armenia, whereas in foreign states, by the diplomatic representations or consular offices of the Republic of Armenia;

(c) on the place of residence in the Republic of Armenia by the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia;

(d) on permanent or temporary residence in foreign states by the diplomatic representations or consular offices of the Republic of Armenia;

(e) on leaving for and returning to foreign states by the border services;

(f) on national origin, upon the request of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia by the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia in the Republic of Armenia, whereas in foreign states, by the diplomatic representations or consular offices of the Republic of Armenia;

(g) on blood group and rhesus by healthcare authorities, upon the request of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia.

Adding other observations to the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia shall be prohibited.

(h) on registration of marriage and divorce by the authorities of civil status acts' registry in the Republic of Armenia, whereas in foreign states, by the diplomatic representations or consular offices of the Republic of Armenia.

7. Citizens of the Republic of Armenia in foreign states shall reside with the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia.

7.1. The dual citizen of the Republic of Armenia shall be issued the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia.

8. Stateless persons and citizens of foreign states shall reside in the Republic of Armenia with the documents prescribed by the legislation of the Republic of Armenia.

9. For issuing a passport, duty shall be levied on the citizen in the manner and amount prescribed by the Law of the Republic of Armenia "On State Duty".

## **II. PROCEDURE OF ISSUING, EXCHANGING A PASSPORT AND USING IT**

10. The passports of the citizens of the Republic of Armenia shall be issued or exchanged in accordance with the permanent, temporary or actual place of residence of the citizens of the Republic of Armenia by the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia in the Republic of Armenia, whereas in foreign states, by the diplomatic representations or consular offices of the Republic of Armenia.

11. For receiving a passport, the citizens of the Republic of Armenia shall submit the following:

- (a) an application of a specified form;
- (b) birth certificate or the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia received until attaining the age of 16;
- (c) two (colour) photos measuring 35mm x 45mm;
- (d) (subpoint repealed by No. 840-N of 8 July 2010);
- (e) other identification documents, if the citizen of the Republic of Armenia is not able to submit the documents referred to in subpoint (b) of this point;

(f) registration certificate or military service record card (for conscripts).

12. To receive or to exchange the passport of a citizen not having attained the age of 16, one of the parents or the legal representative of the citizen not having attained the age of 16 shall submit the following:

(a) an application of a specified form;

(b) birth certificate or the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia received until attaining the age of 16;

(c) two (colour) photos measuring 35mm x 45mm;

(d) in cases prescribed by Articles 11, 16 and 18 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia "On Citizenship of the Republic of Armenia", the written consent of the parents, and in the case prescribed by Article 22, the written consent of the child.

If the parent is not able to submit the consent, then the authenticity of his or her signature on the consent must be certified through notarial procedure.

The passport of the citizen not having attained the age of 16 shall be sent to one of the parents or the legal representative, or another representative.

13. The citizen of the Republic of Armenia may exchange the passport, if the information contained therein has to be changed, there are discrepancies in the records, the passport is unfit for use, as well as in cases prescribed by paragraph 7 of point 1 of this Procedure.

14. To exchange a passport, the citizen of the Republic of Armenia shall submit the passport to be exchanged, the application of a specified form and two photos.

When exchanging the passport for changing any information or as a result of finding discrepancies in the records, the citizen of the Republic of Armenia shall also submit documents verifying the changes or discrepancies.

14.1. The Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia shall issue or exchange a passport on the fifth working day following the filing of the application, except for cases prescribed by point 15 of this Charter.

14.2. ***(paragraph repealed by No. 974-N of 23 June 2011)***

In case if the person having acquired citizenship of the Republic of Armenia, without a permanent place of residence in the Republic of Armenia and the person permanently or mainly residing in a foreign state is documented with the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia, he or she shall be registered in the State Population Register with the address of his or her place of residence in the foreign state.

14.3. When submitting the application defined by points 11, 12, 14 and 15 of this Charter, the citizen shall be notified in writing about the liability provided for by law for submitting false documents or false data.

15. The citizen of the Republic of Armenia shall be obliged to, within a 10-day period, inform the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia in the Republic of Armenia, whereas in foreign states, the diplomatic representations or consular offices of the Republic of Armenia about the loss of the passport.

A case relating to the loss shall be drawn up in the case of loss of the passport. In exchange of the lost passport, a new passport shall be issued on the fifteenth day following the filing of

the application of the citizen to the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia.

15.1. The Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia shall, on the ground of the agreement on provision of paid services, issue or exchange the passport in shorter periods, whereas at the checkpoints on the state border of the Republic of Armenia, observations may be added about the validity period of the passport in foreign states.

15.2. Persons having acquired citizenship of the Republic of Armenia in the manner prescribed by Article 13 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia "On Citizenship of the Republic of Armenia" for the first time shall be issued the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia at the Passport and Visa Department of the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia, except for citizens of the states defined by the decision of the Government of the Republic of Armenia to whom the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia shall be issued for the first time by the diplomatic representations or consular offices of the Republic of Armenia in foreign states for having acquired citizenship of the Republic of Armenia.

Conscripts having acquired citizenship of the Republic of Armenia in the manner prescribed by Article 13 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia "On Citizenship of the Republic of Armenia" shall be registered in the manner prescribed by the legislation of the Republic of Armenia.

16. The person having renounced or having lost citizenship of the Republic of Armenia shall be obliged to surrender the passport to the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia in the Republic of Armenia in the prescribed manner, whereas in foreign states, to the diplomatic representations or consular offices of the Republic of Armenia.

17. The passport of the deceased citizen of the Republic of Armenia shall be surrendered to the authorities in charge of registering the death. After registration of the death, the passport shall be sent to the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia in the prescribed manner.

The passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia deceased in a foreign state shall be surrendered to the diplomatic representation or the consular office of the Republic of Armenia in the foreign state.

18. The passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia is the property of the Republic of Armenia.

Passports that have been found shall be handed to the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia in the Republic of Armenia, whereas in foreign states, to the diplomatic representations or consular offices of the Republic of Armenia;

19. The passports of suspects and accused persons against whom the signature to not leave or detention has been selected as a measure of restraint, as well as those of persons sentenced to imprisonment, shall be temporarily taken by investigative and preliminary

investigative bodies, or the court, whereas the passports of the persons called up for military service shall be taken by the military commissariats.

The passports of suspects and the accused persons shall be returned to the owners in case of elimination of the measure of restraint, the passports of persons called up for military service — after serving punishment or after discharge from military service.

Instead of the passport the suspects and the accused persons not in custody shall be issued an identification document by the investigative or preliminary investigative bodies without permission to leave the Republic of Armenia, the form of which is elaborated and approved by the Police of the Republic of Armenia adjunct to the Government of the Republic of Armenia.

Taking a passport (except for cases referred to in this point), handing the passport to other persons and pledging the passport shall be prohibited.

19.1. The citizen of the Republic of Armenia having been detained or having been sentenced to imprisonment shall be issued a passport or shall exchange it through the administration of the penitentiary establishment of the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Armenia (hereinafter referred to as "penitentiary establishment"). The application of the specified form together with the necessary documents shall be submitted to the corresponding body by the penitentiary establishment.

19.2. The legal representatives of the citizens recognised as legally incapable in the manner prescribed by law shall submit the documents for issuing or exchanging passports and shall receive the passports.

The documents for issuing or exchanging the passport of a citizen on inpatient treatment at a psychiatric hospital or other institution providing psychiatric care shall be prepared and

submitted to the relevant authority by the administration of the psychiatric hospital or other institution providing psychiatric care which shall be issued the passport later on .

19.3. The passports of the conscript citizens of the Republic of Armenia shall be issued and exchanged in the manner prescribed by the legislation of the Republic of Armenia.

**DESCRIPTION  
OF THE PASSPORT OF THE CITIZEN OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

The passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia (measuring 88 x 125 mm, comprised of 32 pages) is the main identification document of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia.

The cover of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia is blue. The word-combination "REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA" is printed in Armenian and in capital letters at the top of the cover. The Coat of Arms of the Republic of Armenia is depicted in the centre. The word "PASSPORT" is printed in Armenian and in capital letters below the Coat of Arms of the Republic of Armenia, and below it, the word-combination "REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA" and the word "PASSPORT" are printed in English and in relatively smaller capital letters.

The Coat of Arms of the Republic of Armenia depicted on the cover, as well as the records are in bronze.

The colourful representation of the Coat of Arms of the Republic of Armenia is depicted in the centre of the reverse side of the cover of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia. The page is edged with a blue design from above and the sides, and the sentence "THIS PASSPORT IS VALID FOR ALL COUNTRIES" is printed in Armenian and in English capital letters at the bottom.

The first page of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia is edged with a light purple design from above and the sides, the Coat of Arms of the Republic of Armenia is depicted inside the design (in the centre), arch-shaped designs are depicted on the top of that and oval-shaped designs — on the bottom of that.

Pages 4-32 of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia are designed in the same manner.

The word-combination "REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA" is printed in Armenian and English capital letters at the top of the first page of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia, and the word "PASSPORT" is printed in Armenian and English capital letters slightly below the image of the Coat of Arms of the Republic of Armenia. The serial number of the passport is indicated at the bottom of the same page, at the centre.

The word-combination "REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA" is printed in Armenian and English capital letters at the top of the second page of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia, below which, in the following sequence, spots shall be allocated to indicate the following data in Armenian:

last name

first name

patronymic name

citizenship

born (day, month, year)

issued (day, month, year)

by (code)

gender

place of birth

valid until (day, month, year)

At the bottom of the same page, in a drawn rectangle, the word-combination "Signature of Holder of the Passport" is printed in Armenian and English. The Coat of Arms of the Republic of Armenia — edged with a circular-shaped design — is depicted on the right side of the same page.

The word-combination "REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA" is printed in Armenian and English capital letters at the top of the third page of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia, below which, in the following sequence, spots are allocated to indicate the following data in English:

name of the document

category

code of the country

number of the passport

last name

first name

citizenship

born (day, month, year)

personal number

gender

place of birth

issued (day, month, year)

valid until (day, month, year)

by (code)

On the left side of the same page a spot are allocated for the photo (measuring 35 x 45 mm) of the holder of the passport, and the Coat of Arms of the Republic of Armenia is depicted on the right side with an edged, oval-shaped design, on which the word-combination "REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA" is printed in English capital letters.

The word-combination "THIS PASSPORT IS VALID FOR FOREIGN COUNTRIES UNTIL" is printed in Armenian and English capital letters at the top of the fourth page of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia, and below it, five lines are drawn for adding observations on the validity period.

The fifth and sixth pages of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia are allocated for observations prescribed by for the Passport System Charter in the Republic of Armenia.

At the top of the mentioned pages the word "OBSERVATIONS" is printed in Armenian and English capital letters.

Pages 7-32 of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia are prescribed for adding observations on permission granted by the relevant competent authorities of foreign states to enter the country. At the top of the mentioned pages the word "OBSERVATIONS" is printed in Armenian and English capital letters.

At the bottom of pages 5-32 of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia, the serial number of the passport is indicated through punching.

At the centre of the last page (on the inside of the cover) of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia, the sentence "THIS PASSPORT IS THE PROPERTY OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA" and "THE HOLDER OF THIS PASSPORT IS UNDER THE PROTECTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA" are printed in Armenian and English capital letters, whereas at the bottom — "THIS PASSPORT CONTAINS 32 PAGES".

The passports of the citizens of the Republic of Armenia shall be prepared in serial numbers, each with circulation of 500,000 (five hundred thousand) copies. Serial numbers shall be indicated in Latin capital letters (AA, AB, AC, etc). The letter "A" shall be placed in the beginning of all serial numbers. The numbering of the passports of the citizens of the Republic of Armenia shall start with 0200001 and end with 0700000 figures, except for AF passports, the numbering of which shall start with 0200001 and end with 0800000 figures, and for AM passports, the numbering shall start with 0200001 and end with 0950000 figures, and for AN passports, the numbering shall start with 0200001 and end with 0800000 figures.

All pages of the passport of the citizen of the Republic of Armenia shall be numbered in Arabic numerals.
