**ON MAKING SUPPLEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS TO THE LAW OF THE REPUBLIC OF
ARMENIA ON NARCOTIC DRUGS AND PSYCHOTROPIC SUBSTANCES**

Article 1. In fifth paragraph of Article 3 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia No HO-518-N of 26 December 2002 “On Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances” (hereinafter referred to as “the Law”), the word “wholesale,” shall be added after the word “processing,”.

Article 2. In Article 10 of the Law, the words “the authorised public administration body” shall be replaced by “the Government of the Republic of Armenia”.

Article 3. In Article 13(3) of the Law, the words “in case of availability of the licence for the specified activities” shall be deleted.

Article 4. In Article 14 of the Law:

(1) part 2 shall be repealed;

(2) in part 3, the words “and preparation” shall be deleted.

Article 5. In Article 15 of the Law, the words “in case of availability of the licence for the specified type of activities” shall be deleted.

Article 6. The Law shall be supplemented with Article 15.1, which reads as follows:

“Article 15.1. Wholesale of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances

Wholesale of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances shall be carried out in accordance with the procedure established by the Government of the Republic of Armenia, in case of availability of the licence for the specified type of activities.”.

Article 7. In Article 16 of the Law, the words “in case of availability of the licence for the specified type of activities” shall be deleted.

Article 8. In Article 18(1) of the Law, the words “in case of availability of the license for the specified type of activities” shall be deleted.

Article 9. In Article 20 of the Law, the words “in case of availability of the licence for the specified type of activities” shall be deleted.

Article 10. In Article 21 of the Law, the words “in case of availability of the licence for the specified type of activities” shall be deleted.

Article 11. Articles 31 and 32 shall be repealed.

Article 12. This Law shall enter into force from 1 January 2011.
